The new bridge features eight lines of 11 girders, with each component measuring 11 feet (3.4 meters) tall and weighing up to 48 tons apiece.

On the morning of June 28, 1983, at around 1:30 a.m., an eastbound section of the bridge fell into the chilly waters of the river, leaving three people dead and others injured. Each bridge span was 30 m (100 ft) long, three travel lanes wide, with a 53 skew.

The thunderous roar of the collapse was heard ten km (six miles) away in Quebec (p.80, Middleton, 2001). The entire south half of the bridge, approximately 189 MN (19,000 tons) of steel, fell into the waters of the St. Lawrence within 15 seconds. Eighty-six workers were present on the bridge at the time.

### **CASE OF THE BRIDGE TO GRETNA - Clemmons 1 Caitlynd ...**

On the 28th of June 1983 at 1.30am, a 30m section of the eastbound span collapsed and fell 21m into the River Mianus. The section collapsed as two tractor-trailers and two automobiles crossed the span. Three people were killed and a further three were seriously injured.

### **The Mianus River Bridge Collapse Introduction**

The Ocoee River made history during the 1996 Olympic Games in Atlanta, Georgia, as the first-ever natural river to serve as the site for the whitewater canoe and kayak events. Bridges were needed to get spectators, officials and equipment across the raging rapids. To meet this challenge, Betts Engineering chose a 10-ft. wide, 336-ft. long Continental ® cable-stayed pedestrian bridge.

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
