White cement typically contains 0.4% or less iron oxide (Fe₂O₃) rather than 2.6% for gray portland cement ("gray cement"). As Table 1 shows, four chemical compounds characterize portland cement: C 3 S, C 2 S, C 3 A, and C 4 AF. Calcium aluminoferrite, or C 4 AF in shorthand notation, is the compound that most influences cement color.
