A second alternative to full probate upon the death of a spouse is for the surviving spouse to file an Application for Probate and Petition for Summary Administration. This proceeding is available when the surviving spouse is the sole beneficiary of the decedent's estate, either by will or intestacy (law that applies when someone dies without a will).

Verify the original Will at the Probate Counter, Registry of the Family Justice Court. Present court papers to extract the Grant of Probate. Documents include originating summons, supporting affidavit and schedule of assets. The whole process may take 3 to 6 months. You may receive the Grant of Probate within a month of filing the last court document.
